

Total Positive COVID-19 Cases From 23/08/2020 to 05/09/2020 by Wirral Wards







COVID-19 RELATED MORTALITY


cumulative number of COVID-19 related deaths in Wirral

number of positive cases up to 4 September 2020 by Pillar 1 and Pillar 2 testing³






